KATA: 1. Beginners and Novice must perform a basic kata. Beginner and Novice may repeat the same kata.

2. Intermediate and Advanced divisions are open kata but must perform a different kata in medal rounds. Adult Black belts and ages 15-17 advanced divisions compete first.

KUMITE: WKF rules with the following modifications:

- 2. Juniors 17 and under ......Head contact must be penalized
- 3. Juniors 15-17 advanced and Adults 18-34 advanced .......Competes First
- 4. Adults (except WKF Div)...... 3 minutes stop time, 8 point ceiling
- 5. Adult advanced ......WKF Rules

KOBUDO:

Adult 18 & Over

All weapons will be subject to inspection by judges before competition. Modified weapons or weapons that do not meet tournament criteria may not be used in competition. 6ft Bo must weigh at least 900 grams. Weapons must remain in the competitor's hands at all times.
